New Business

Weed Control: Frank reported that the lake was treated June 8th from Charlie Maxwell's and Turtle Cove northward and on June 12th they treated the south part of the lake. There is map of the areas they treated. We are hoping for low weeds this year.

Weed Boat: Doug has nothing new to report. Roman said we will schedule a training on how to use it soon.

Village Update: Roman said they installed the new bathroom plumbing fixtures on the island. They were working on the temporary doors this week. Next week the metal security doors will be installed. The police are locking the island every night around dusk and DPS unlocks it at 7:30 am in the morning. There are some new water mains being installed and gas lines as well in town. Also, some work at the water treatment plant is being completed. Anne asked about whether village property is considered in the flood plain. We discussed that the village had opted out years ago and no one was familiar with recent maps. She was going to ask the township about it. Roman also said that they are also doing more shoreline restoration on the island as well.
