Treasurer's Report- Anne reported we have \$11,843.28 in the bank. We received some dues money, paid for the flags and also sold some merchandise. Diane moved to accept the report, Sherry Seconded, all in favor. Anne said they have some small bills to pay for the ladies of the lake. The Board agreed to have Anne pay them and the insurance bill..

Weed Control- Don talked to the applicator Aquatic Weed Control and he sent Frank the contract for next year. Roman reviewed the contract. Next years permit may be a bit more than this year. Anne was told by some residents that a tree is in the lake. The lake association has no control over trees that fall in the lake.

Weed Boat- Doug had nothing to report.

Boat parade- Sherry said we had 10 boats in the parade and had a great time. People decorated some boats and we will do this again next year. There were some people on shore watching the parade.

Village Updates- Roman said the Maple Isle Bridge work continues, hopefully done in October. The Dam project is also underway, completion in December, with some finish work in the spring. The walking bridge will not have a roof for the time being. The kayak launch will be removed this fall per usual. We have to file the annual report to the State of Michigan. He will need a check for \$20 at a later date. Roman suggested that we ask Aquatic Weed Control for their insurance certificate.

Frank gave some meeting updates. Michigan Lakes and Streams is having a meeting September 23rd at Porter Township Hall 5pm to 8pm about Tree Planting. They ask you RSVP to the MLSA and dinner is provided. The Region 3 Lake Meeting is at 9am on September 27th at Porter Hall as well.
