Anne made motion to approve minutes of last meeting, Diane seconded, all in favor.

Treasurers Report: Anne reports we have \$9,818.01 in the bank account. We will need to pay insurance and supplies for the picnic soon. Doug made motion to accept report, Dona seconded, All in favor.

Dock Relocation - Doug said that he discussed the old dock with Roman and putting it on the island. We will wait till next year to install it because it is late in the year.

Village Parks and Recreation Meeting- Diane said they are focusing on 3 things. The rental kayak kiosk, Kids Paradise and pickle ball courts. They will be getting some numbers together on costs for these projects. Some playground equipment may be moved around from Cedar St to Kids Paradise or the park at Miller/Harris. Freshwater is doing some pickle ball courts as well.

Weed Control- Don reports that the lake looks good, had a little bit of algae when it got hot but it has cleaned up.

Weed Boat- Doug said nothing new to report. It's not in the water.

Maple Lake Picnic at 5:30 on September 6th at Maple Island, bring a dish to pass. The association will provide the barbecued meat and buns.

Village Updates- Roman said they are finishing up on Briggs dam, we will have a grand opening event soon. The lighting will go in soon at the dam as well. Frank said he liked the style/look of the new dam. Roman said the village committee that works on water issues is looking at communities that have removed sediment to see what other communities are doing.

Web Site- Dona reported that we had more traffic in June and July because of all the notices and events and blog activity. The Facebook and email activity is about the same.

Social Committee- Sherry said they have the poker run signs and will have balloons at the stops. We will start at Annes dock at 5pm on August 29th. A new reminder email went out to the association members. Hopefully people will show up. Diane will place a sign at the Shelter on the island to reserve it for the picnic. Sherry will watch the weather in case the poker run needs to be cancelled and alert the Board and membership.
